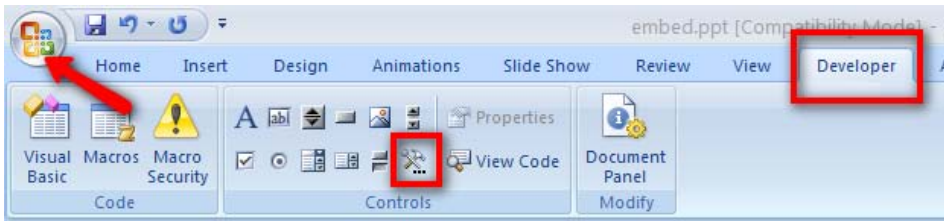
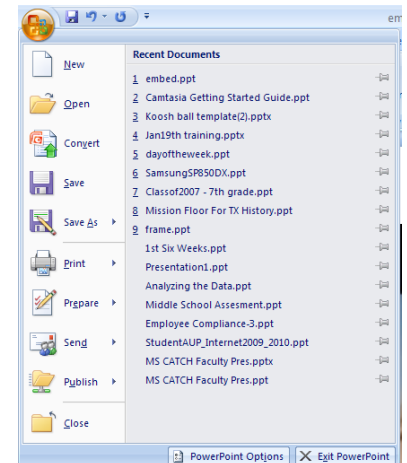


To embed a YouTube Video into PowerPoint 2007:



Note: Your computer must have internet connection when showing the PowerPoint in order for the video to work.

1. Look to see if the “Developer” ribbon is available on your toolbar. If it is NOT:
 - click on the Microsoft Orb (see red arrow)
 - Click on “PowerPoint Options” on the bottom of the window.
 - Under the “Popular” tab check S”Show Developer tab in the Ribbon”
 - Click “OK”



2. Open the Developer’s Ribbon and click on the “More Controls” option in the Controls box.
3. Scroll down and select the option “Shockwave Flash Object” and click “OK.”
4. On the PowerPoint slide click the mouse and draw a box where you want the video to be.



5. Right click on the box you have just drawn and select “Properties.”
6. Open Internet Explorer and find the video you want to embed in your presentation:

- Copy the URL in the address bar by highlighting the address and Ctrl + C

7. Return to PowerPoint
8. Paste the URL in the Properties Box in the “Movie” section.
9. Change the URL by:

- Delete the “watch?” portion of the address
- Replace the “=” with a “/”
- Example
 - From: <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=aSVfywdGSsQ>
 - To: <http://www.youtube.com/v/aSVfywdGSsQ>

10. Other items to change in the Properties Box:

- Loop – If you want the movie to play through once and stop select “False”
- Playing – If you want the movie to start automatically when the slide loads – “True” – Otherwise change to “False” if you want to click on the movie for it to start.

11. Save your PowerPoint.

12. Run the presentation and you should see the movie begin.
